STRASBOURG, France LOGIS HÔTEL ETTENHEIM

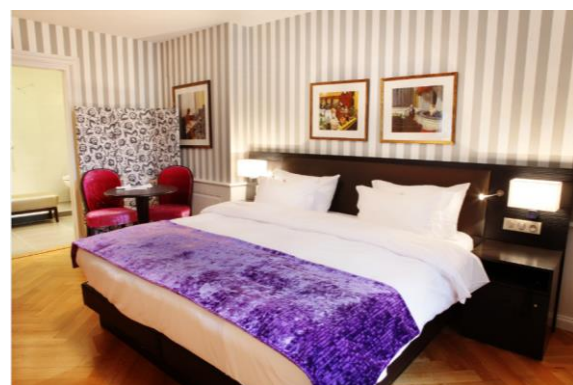

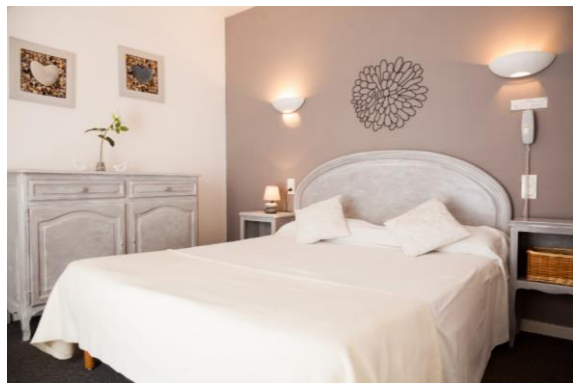

AVIGNON, France LOGIS HÔTEL LE PETIT MANOIR
